- Wander through the historic lanes of Fort Kochi and Mattancherry, where Arab, European, and South Asian trading cultures intersected for centuries.
- Experience temple towns and coastal monuments on foot, allowing history to unfold at a human pace rather than from behind a windshield.

- Experience the vibrant, ongoing ritual life of Madurai's Meenakshi Temple, one of India's great living temple complexes.



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
